

## Application and Removal Instructions for Decals

These decals are made from high-quality vinyl rated for approximately five (5) years of outdoor use. It is not recommended that they be applied to painted surfaces.

To apply:

- Clean surface (car window, phone case, water bottle, etc) with rubbing alcohol. Allow time to dry
- Remove the decal by carefully peeling the clear transfer tape away from the white paper backing ensuring the decal remains on the clear transfer tape. If any of the decal begins to stick to the white paper backing, rub the clear transfer tape gently to get the decal to stick to it, then continue to peel the backing off.
- Place the decal with the clear transfer tape against the application surface.
- Gently rub the decal area with your fingers, a flat tool, or the edge of a credit card to make the decal adhere itself to the surface.
- Slowly begin peeling back the transfer tape at a 45 degree angle, ensuring the decal remains on the application surface. If the decal sticks to the transfer tape, rub the decal and apply pressure as you continue to peel it away. A fingernail can be used to peel the edge from the tape as long as the edge of the decal does not get curled.
- Ensure small details, such as "i" dots and letter centers, are adhered to application surface.

If applied to drinkware hand washing is recommended; do not soak in water. Dishwasher and Microwave are discouraged to ensure the longevity of the decal on the drinkware surface.

When you want to remove your decal, suggested methods of removal include:

- Applying heat
- Scraping with a razor blade
- Using rubbing alcohol

Decals are not reusable once removed.
